This exhibition is **free to enter** and unlike our normal exhibitions there is no expectation to steward; although we would highly recommend visiting the venue of The Woolpack to view your artwork alongside our other member's work.

You must be a **current member of Bafa** (Membership year 2018) to exhibit. Membership purchased at this point (October 2018) to exhibit in this exhibition will also allow you to exhibit in our main exhibition this year at The Buckingham Community Centre on the weekend of 16th – 18th November. Any artwork hung at the pub will not be available to hang in the community centre.

Completing this entry form is committing your intention of exhibiting your artwork and it will need to be brought to the pub by yourself or another, on the morning of 31st October to allow hanging to take place. We have been asked to fill the pub with artwork for this occasion, please ensure we get to see your work on the walls. Email Emily on the address below if you would like to, on this occasion only, drop off your work in advance if Wednesday 31st October is not convenient.

There is not an opportunity to sell greetings cards or browser work. Artwork must be suitable for hanging on the wall and artists should have their own insurance to cover the value of the piece/s on display. Security is very good at the pub, but due to the venue not being stewarded by Bafa members during this exhibition, the Bafa Committee and pub management don't hold any liability for pieces stolen during opening hours. CCTV does cover some areas of the pub but not all walls are seen. We try to use security hooks for small or vulnerable pieces of work that might be taken without others noticing. These are not completely fool proof but they do deter chancers.

No commission will be taken on any sales from this exhibition. This in line with the pub managements wishes to take an active, positive role in our community.
