

Background

Buckingham Art For All, or Bafa for short, is a not for profit organisation founded in January 2008. It was created to service the demand for a local art organisation. It has grown rapidly over the last two years and now has 70 members. Activities have grown to include a monthly programme of demonstrations/workshops, trips to galleries and spring and autumn exhibitions.

Objectives

The objectives of Bafa were primarily as follows: -

- To provide an environment where members of all abilities could meet and exchange experiences.
- To enable members to educate other members via informal self help groups or networking.
- To provide a venue where members could meet monthly to experience demonstrations and talks by other experienced members or professionals.
- To organise trips to galleries and events of an artistic nature.
- To create a framework for a group of likeminded people to meet informally, rather than as a formal society.
- To create an atmosphere that was quite laid back, above all fun and, in essence, to feel a bit different from other societies around and about.
- To enable members to exhibit work irrespective of ability.
